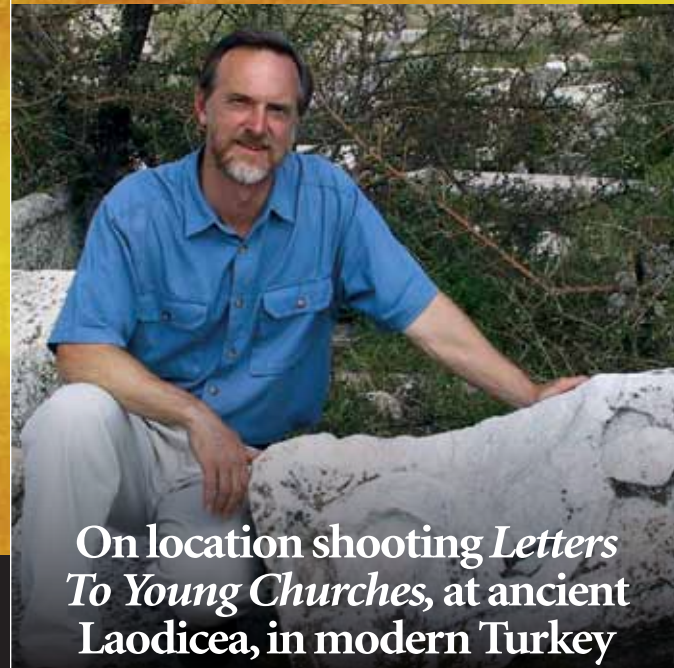

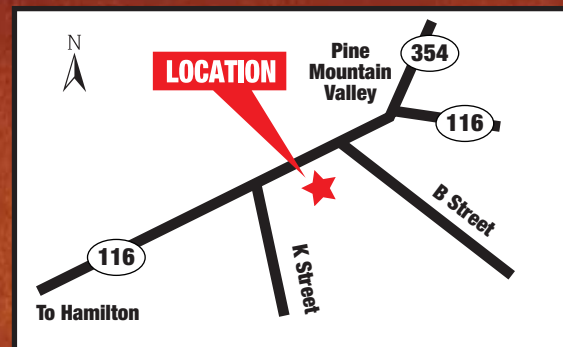

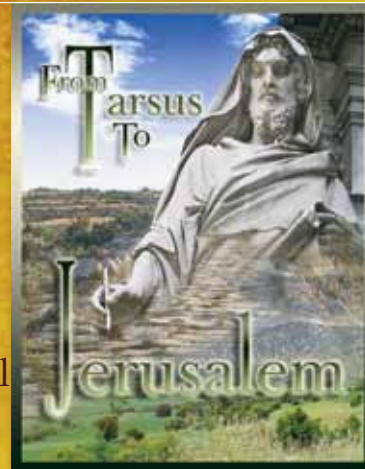

1 From Tarsus To Jerusalem THURSDAY, JANUARY 29 AT 7:00 P.M.

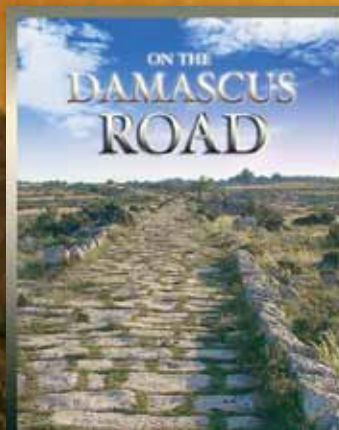

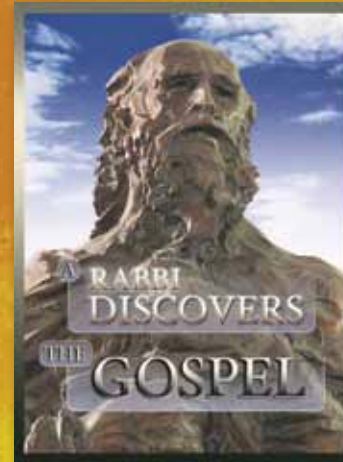


2 THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 5 AT 7:00 P.M.

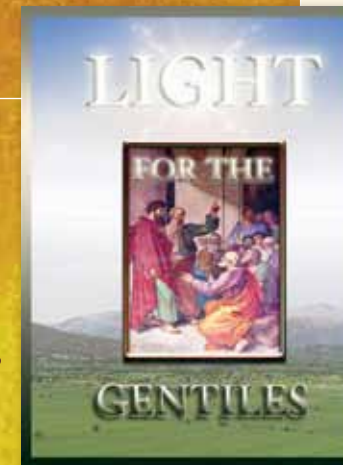
3 THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 12 AT 7:00 P.M.

5 THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 26 AT 7:00 P.M.

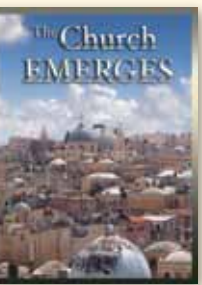

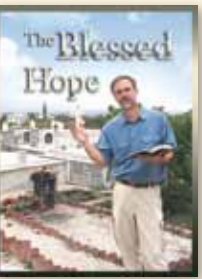

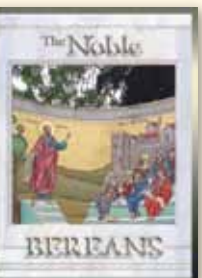
