In The Footsteps Of Paul Begins
Independent Filmmaker Tony Moore presents "In The Footsteps Of Paul"

[LOCATION], (DATE) — In The Footsteps Of Paul is coming to _____ on _____. In this fascinating twenty-part series Tony Moore, an independent filmmaker from Southern California will take you back in time to understand the world of the Apostle Paul. Each presentation was filmed on-location and brings fresh meaning to Paul's teachings by applying them to our life in the 21st century. This spectacular series was filmed in Turkey, Israel, Syria, Jordan, Greece and Italy.

Each presentation consists of two components.

- 1. Viewing the on-location report by Tony Moore of Paul's journey.
- 2. Exploring a rich full-color study guide that reviews where you have been, including a map for geographical reference. There are also personal application questions that apply Paul's teachings to our lives in the 21st century.

Here is an overview of the first week's program.

From Tarsus To Jerusalem

Thursday, Sept. 25

In the opening episode of this inspiring series you will explore the background of the great Apostle Paul. You will travel to Tarsus, the capital of the Roman Province of Cilicia, where he was born. Paul said he was a citizen of no ordinary city, and indeed Tarsus wasn't. Here Mark Anthony established his residence and here he first met Cleopatra. Discover why Tarsus was so important to Rome. Then travel to Jerusalem where the young Saul was schooled at the feet of Gamaliel. Explore the schools of Judaism prevalent in the first century city, and understand the branch he chose. The young rabbi's life would be dramatically changed through his encounter with Stephen, the first Christian martyr.

Filmed on location in Tarsus, Caesarea and Jerusalem.

On The Damascus Road

Friday, Sept. 26

As Saul walked the road to Damascus the Holy Spirit stirred his conscience. Trace his journey from Jerusalem, down to Jericho, up the Jordan Valley, around the Sea of Galilee to Damascus. See how the Holy Spirit captured the heart of this misdirected zealot, transforming his life "On The Damascus Road."

Also hear Tony's personal "Damascus Road" testimony of how he was converted at a Rolling Stones concert!

Filmed on location in Jerusalem, Capernaum, the Mount of Beatitudes, Caesarea Philippi, and Damascus.

A Rabbi Discoveries The Gospel

Saturday, Sept. 27

Saul left Jerusalem with authority to arrest the Jewish believers in Damascus, but he entered that city led by the hand because he was blind! As he sat alone in the darkness, his eyes were opened to see Jesus as his Messiah. Don't miss the thrilling story of how a Jewish Rabbi discovered the gospel in Damascus!

Filmed on location in Damascus.

Light To The Gentiles

Monday, Sept. 29

Barnabas invited Saul to teach at Antioch, where believers were first called Christians. This set them apart and sent them out to distant lands to share the Good News of Jesus. Follow in their footsteps as they bring "Light To The Gentiles!"

Filmed on location in Antioch, Perga, Kovanlik and Pisidian Antioch.

When Paul Got Stoned

Tuesday, Sept. 30

Jews and Gentiles responded to the gospel Paul and Barnabas were preaching in distant lands. In Lystra, when they healed a cripple they were identified as Hermes and Zeus. Soon the fickle crowd turned on them, dragging Paul out of the city and stoning him. Don't miss the exciting story of what happened when Paul got stoned!"

Filmed on location in Pisidian Antioch, Iconium, Lystra, Attalia, and Antioch on the Orontes.

The Church Emerges

Thursday, October 2

This interesting episode looks at the birth pangs of the church and how the Jewish believers emerged from Judaism to form the Christian Church. Filmed on location in Antioch this presentation provides invaluable background to understanding the issues of the first century church.
