The tour date is September 25 - October 15, 2006. A special syllabus will be prepared for all tour participants. Contact The Biblical World for specific details and pricing.

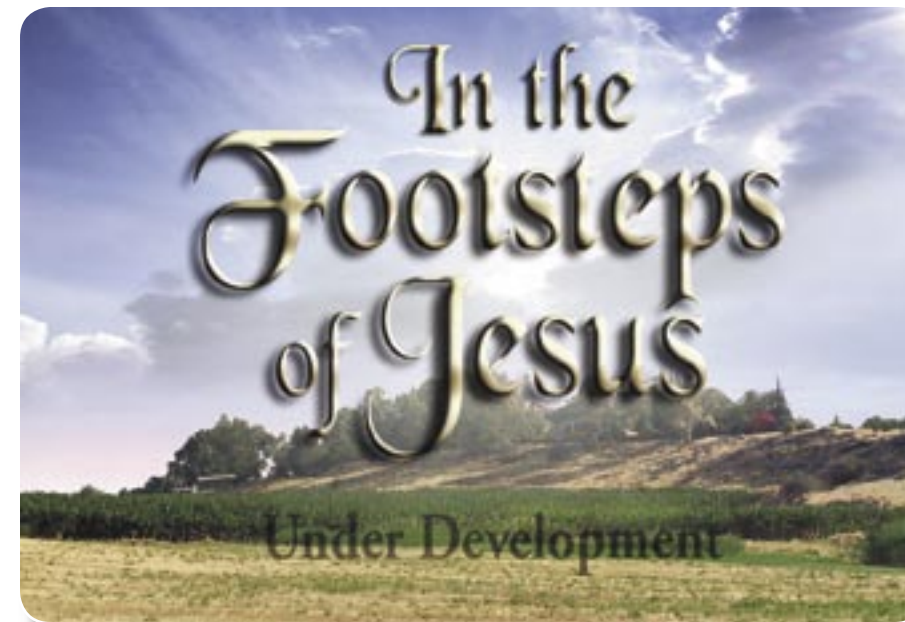
In The Footsteps Of Jesus

It is wonderful to look back over the past two years and see how the Lord has used our series on the life of Paul. I am amazed when I watch "In The Footsteps Of Paul" on the Hope Channel or SAFE TV and think of how many people around the world are being touched by this series. What began as a simple desire to create a new evangelistic resource for small groups has grown to have worldwide impact. I could tell you countless stories (you can read some of them in this newsletter) of how In The Footsteps Of Paul is making a difference in our world.

Pastors and lay leaders are using this series in small group meetings in homes, Sabbath Schools, community evangelism and follow-up to public evangelistic meetings.

Several churches in the Phoenix area are using this series as a follow-up to the It Is Written "The Appearing" meetings held this winter.

The series on Paul grew out of a series I developed on Biblical Archaeology in 1990. This series featuring Egypt, Petra, Jerusalem and Jesus had tremendous appeal to the public, so I naturally thought this would be our next video project.

But in the winter of 2004 the country and the world began to buzz about a new Hollywood film soon to be released by Mel Gibson, "The Passion of Christ."

In February of 2004 It Is Written Quebec invited me to come to Montreal and present In The Footsteps Of Paul in French. As I drove up

the east coast I was amazed by the hot discussion on the radio about "The Passion." From NPR to Christian radio, people were discussing this film on the final hours of Jesus life.

It Is Written invited their viewers to come to the Il Est Escrit study center and learn about the life of Paul. One evening one of the guests said, "I saw the 'Passion of Christ' this week. Your program on Paul is excellent and should be made into a movie for wider circulation like the Passion. You should produce a series like this on the life of Jesus!"

The Lord used this comment to convict me that I needed to produce a series on the life of Jesus that would be faithful to Scripture, history and archaeology. With all of the publicity created by "The Passion" there would be a desire for people and churches to delve deeper into the life of Jesus.

The only problem was, this did not fit into my time line. You see, I had already decided that our next series would be on Biblical Archaeology, because it has proven over the years to have tremendous appeal to a broad range of less religiously inclined people as well as to solid church members.

And yet, that man's words stuck in my soul. I began to feel a deep conviction in my heart that the Lord had spoken to me through this guest at our meetings. As I prayed about the matter it became clear that we should capitalize on the interest created by Mel Gibson's movie. I was sure that a series examining the life of Jesus in the light of history, archaeology and culture would have tremendous appeal beyond the Christian church.

I decided that we must tackle this project right away. I was very naive as to how much work and energy it would take to complete the series on Paul, releasing it on DVD, then preparing it for release on television. Then came the request for translation into various languages and suddenly two years have passed.

During this time I have been researching and preparing scripts for the new series on the life of Jesus. Some of the scripts have been used at campmeetings, pastoral meetings and even at a Conference Prayer Retreat. The response has been so positive and encouraging.

Each episode has something unusual and special to attract the attention, stimulate the imagination and apply truth to the heart. I can hardly wait to see this tremendous series completed. I know the Holy Spirit will use this tool to impact the lives of people around the world and change their hearts for eternity!

In October I will travel to Israel and Lebanon to shoot b-roll and establish where we will film the various scenes. In March-April I will return with a small crew to film the series. The series will be in post-production during the summer and should be available in the fall of 2007.

Recently, I was asked by a supporter "What will it cost to produce this series on Jesus?"

"Oh, about \$200,000" I said.

He then replied, "What will it really cost?"

I began to work on a serious budget allowing for professionals to do various aspects of the project and realized that it would cost \$200,000 to produce the video portion of this series.

To author and replicate the DVDs and prepare the graphics and print the quality study guides would cost another \$200,000. I was stunned.

A.S.I. has generously committed \$20,000 toward the development of this project. That is 10% of the projected film cost or 5% of the entire project.

Let me be honest, there are times when I look at these projected costs and then look at our

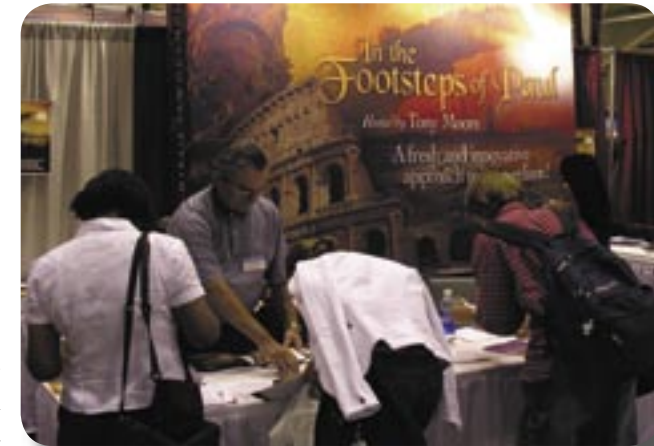

St. Louis General Conference Report

Our booth was extremely active at the General Conference Session of Seventh-day Adventist in St. Louis last July. We literally had thousands of people stop by and visit our booth. Over 1,500 people filled out request forms to receive a DVD Sampler of the Footsteps of Paul.

Helen and Tony Moore were joined in the booth by three dear friends: Dietmar and Pat Fuchs (whom Tony had baptized 25 years earlier in Stamford, CT) and Sue Walden. For eleven days they answered questions about The Biblical World and the Footsteps of Paul. More than two thirds of the requests for Sampler DVDs came from people living outside of North America.
